# From Crisis to Stability: Allondrae's Journey



Allondrae Jones came to SafeHouse Outreach after fleeing a domestic violence situation and relocating from Florida, where she had been living in her car while caring for her teenage niece and nephew. She was referred to us by our partner, Goodwill Metropolitan, after earning her phlebotomy certification.

Determined to rebuild her life, Allondrae joined our Work Ready Program, where she attended workshops, volunteered, and secured part-time employment. With support from our team, including move-in assistance, she was able to move into her own apartment.

She has since been hired in passenger services through an airport partnership and has also received an opportunity in her certified field of phlebotomy.

Today, Allondrae is employed, housed, and preparing to reunite her family. Her story is a powerful reminder that with support and determination, new beginnings are possible.
